

Bucknell Charts Plan For Howard Exchange

Howard University and Bucknell are planning an exchange program for second semester. It is a reciprocal plan which allows Bucknell students to attend Howard and an equal number of Howard students to spend a semester here. The purpose of the program is to allow students to participate in the student life of the two campuses.

The cost of the semester is approximately the same at either school, and all credits will be transferred. It is preferred that applicants be juniors in programs other than engineering, although others may apply.

Bucknell students Biff Ries, Frank Wood and Tom VanAlen have attended Howard on the exchange program. Interested students may talk to them or to Professor John Wheatcroft or Dean Frank Abbott.

An exchange weekend is also being planned. To be held in the spring, it will be a reciprocal program in which Bucknell students visit Howard and Howard students visit Bucknell for a weekend.
