The United Negro College Fund, under chairmanship of Lindsley F. Kimbell, vice president of the Rockefeller Foundation, seeks to raise \$25,000,000 in capital funds over a period of five years. The funds will be distributed among the 31 private accredited colleges and universities associated in the Negro College Fund. To date, \$12,500,000 has been secured.
