## Ramsey Tells About Ethics and the Sit-In

Dr. R. Paul Ramsey, Paine Professor of Religion at Princeton University and chairman of his department since 1959, will speak to Bucknell students Sun. at 2:30 in room 102A Coleman Hall. Dr. Ramsey's discussion will concern his recent book, "Christian Ethics and the Sit-In," and is being given in preparation for Religion-In-Life Week to be held Nov. 11-14.

A teacher and scholar in the field of Christian ethics and social theory, Dr. Ramsey is the author of several volumes and is a frequent contributor of articles to religious and philosophical publications. Among these publications are "Basic Christian Ethics"; "War and the Christian Conscience"; "How Shall War be Justly Conducted"; and "Nine Modern Moralists."

Dr. Ramsey, a graduate of Millsaps College, where he received his Bachelor of Science degree, earned his B. D. and Ph. D. at the Yale University Divinity School. He has taught at Millsaps College, Yale, Northwestern University, Garrett Theological Seminary and Princeton University. He is a member of the American Philosophical Association and vice president of the American Theological Society in 1959.
