Because there has been concern on the part of students, faculty, and administration about Bucknell's appropriate role in the civil rights picture, a group of faculty and students have invited Dr. Robert Martin of Howard to meet with interested people on this Saturday afternoon, December 7.

Dr. Martin is Professor of Government at Howard University in Washington. He has helped to train most of the lawyers who are involved now in civil rights legislation, works closely with the Department of Justice in civil rights cases, is thoroughly competent in both the history and present status in civil rights legislation. He is presently training a Peace Corps unit for Gaboa. As a Negro legal and human rights authority, he will be very helpful in this discussion to which interested Bucknellians are invited.

We also anticipate that Dr. Samuel Proctor, President of The Agricultural and Technical College of Greensboro, South Carolina, will be here with us. As a Negro college president, he is daily familiar with the problem. He has also just returned from two year's service directing the Peace Corps in Nigeria.
