

SIX BUCKNELL STUDENTS GO TO NAACP MEETING AT HOWARD UNIVERSITY

The National Association for the Advancement of Colored People held its third annual youth legislative conference at Howard University in Maryland, April 20-23.

A delegation of six members of the Bucknell chapter attended the conference along with young people, representing NAACP youth and college chapters of almost every state in the union.

Dr. Cyrus Karraker, Dr and Mrs. Manning Smith, Marcia Fremont, Beverly Dunston, and Jeannette Bowling were the local members who attended the meet.

Effective techniques for lobbying, the NAACP legislative program and organizational problems formed the basis for discussion. Primary emphasis, however, centered around the passage of legislation, such as an effective FECP bill, anti-poll, and anti-lynching bills, and a bill for the extension of social security to domestic and agricultural workers.
